

New Employees





This past September the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities conducted a review of all the programs and services the Fayette County Board of DD offers. The review included the following areas: Early Intervention, Adult Services, Service and Support Administration, Self Advocacy, Transportation and Personnel. It gives me great pride to report that out of a possible score of 100%, Fayette County scored 96.4%. As a result, the County Board was awarded a 4 Year Accreditation and can petition the DODD for a 5 year award. Currently, Renee Guess is coordinating those efforts for the agency.

The Accreditation Award has special significance because it demonstrates substantial improvement in program services from three years ago when the County Board received a 3 year award.

I want to take this time to congratulate all of the staff who work day after day to assist people to become the best version of themselves. Secondly, I want to thank The Board, elected officials, and all members of the community who support the work we do. And finally, I want to thank families who trust us to provide quality services to their loved ones.
