The Superintendent Search update was a given by the Personnel Committee. They attended a meeting on Monday, March 10th with Randy Beach, OACBDD and Highland County Board of DD. The Job has been posted and they are waiting on applications to arrive. They are in the process of selecting questions to be asked in the interviews.
